NOTES: 1. The Yanello and Keeley crews suffered a mid-air collision while letting down near Great Ashfield after a mission to Reims-Champaigne. Windshield fogging was the primary cause. Both crews were on their 11th missions. Just nine days earlier, John Schley's aircraft collided with an aircraft from another Group. Only John Adams, tail gunner on Yanello's crew, survived these crashes.

^{2.} Captain Hutchinson's and Lt. Pease's aircraft also had a mid-air collision over Reedham Marsh, Norfolk, England. Hutchinson's crew was on its 25th mission. The collision occurred during letdown after returning from a mission to Diepholz. 21 airmen were lost in this accident.

^{3.} Phillip Vockerath was our only fatality of the "Black Thursday" mission to Schweinfuert, Germany. The aircraft piloted by Bob Vandiver was so badly shot up that it was diverted to a crash field for landing.

^{4.} Sgt. Sturdivant died when he as ordered to bail out. His parachute failed to open. His pilot and co-Pilot were forced to ditch in the Channel.
